COVID-19 Key Control Measures

This arrangement sets out key control measures that will be implemented across our Club.

These measures are vital to reduce the risk of spreading infection.

Control Measure - Hand hygiene

Hand hygiene procedures are key in minimising the risk of surface contamination.

Halls will provide hand sanitising stations and they will be located at entrance and exit areas of the hall together with paper towels and a bin.

There will be a one-way flow In and Out of the building, to avoid contact with people waiting for the next class to begin.

Only one person to use the hand sanitising area and toilets at any one time, observing social distancing.

Numbers per class will be limited to adhere to social distancing rules, bookings are in operation to avoid overcrowding.

Before entry, all windows will be open to ensure good ventilation and prior to each class all touch arears will be wiped down, which consist of all flat surfaces, including door handles, windowsills, light switches etc.

On arrival all members will have their temperatures taken digitally and be required to sign in with name and telephone number for the Government Mandatory Track and Trace system.

Face coverings are not mandatory but can be worn if preferred.

If any member uses the toilet, they must wash their hands for 20 seconds and before entering the hall use the hand sanitiser to re-join the class. This also applies to the instructors.
